Description of merchandise to be sold:

- All merchants must meet all State and Local legal requirements to sell goods and services within the State of Colorado and Jefferson County. I will furnish all required permits, if applicable, upon request.
- Dragonfest of Colorado Inc. reserves the right to exclude the sales of inappropriate merchandise.
- The sale of alcohol is strictly prohibited. The only exception is pre-bottled herbal, homeopathic tinctures of 5oz or less.
- Merchants selling knives, sword, axes and any items which would commonly be called a weapon may only sell to individuals 18 years or older. Dragonfest asks that all vendors require an adult be present before allowing a minor into any area where these items are displayed. These items must also be security tagged or taped to their sheath when sold.
- Dragonfest of Colorado, Inc requires that each merchant booth have its own fire extinguisher displayed at all times in a visible and easily accessible location.
- Merchant Setup will be Tuesday, August 5th from 10am to 8pm.
- Merchants will be limited to two helpers. Helpers must be on the Merchant Early Arrival list no later then June 1st.
- Merchants are required to perform a standard 2 hour work shift as are all participants of the retreat. Opening day morning shifts are held for merchants on a “first come, first serve” basis.
- Merchants renting tables and/or chairs from Dragonfest are solely responsible for ensuring they are returned to the Merchant Coordinators, in good condition, prior to leaving Retreat grounds. Failure to do so will result in a \$25.00 lost or damage item fee for each missing or damaged item.
- Merchants are responsible for ensuring their booth and camping area is completely free of any trash or debris on their departure from the retreat.
- Merchant booths and camping areas immediately along the lake front may not drain or dispose of any waste products that could contaminate the lake, including but not limited, to grey water and/or dish and shower run off with out the express permission of both Dragonfest and Castle Mountain Recreation.
- Dragonfest firmly believes in leaving the land better then the state we found it in. Merchants that fail to completely clean their booth site at the conclusion of the retreat will no be invited back the following year.
- I understand and am aware that there are risks involved in my participation in Dragonfest 2008, including the rugged nature of the site, and take full responsibility for my safety and well being as well as the safety and well being of any minors in my charge. I agree not to sue and/or press any actions or claims against Dragonfest organizers and agents for any injury, loss or illness occurring to me or to anyone through whom I may claim at said event RESULTING FROM ACCIDENT, NEGLIGENCE OR MY PARTICIPATION IN ANY AND/OR ALL ACTIVITIES sponsored by or related to Dragonfest. This agreement is binding upon my heirs, executors and assigns.**
